









The Gaskell Recreation Ground Management Committee is responsible for the day-to-day management of the ground and since the last Annual General Meeting the Committee has:

-  Held a consultation with members of the public to on the future of the ground
-  Considered health and safety on the ground
-  Delayed plans to remove the hedgerow adjacent to the children's playground due to it being removed in a wider drainage scheme
-  Investigated drainage issues and arranged for jetting to be carried out
-  Met with Severn Trent to try to determine ownership of the underground tank in the children's playground
-  Met with users of the ground
-  Reviewed fees for users of the ground
-  Engaged a new contractor to carry out grounds maintenance

The Committee has been meeting on a monthly basis but, at its last meeting held on 20 April 2016, the Committee agreed to meet informally, as and when required, and to meet formally when a formal decision needed to be made.
