

USE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL'S SEAL

Registration

The Town Council's Seal has been registered under the Trade Marks Act 1994 of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

The Seal has been registered under No. 2559808 as of the date 27 September 2010 and certified on 15 April 2011.

The colours shown in the Mark are:

- Pantone Red 120
- Pantone Green 95
- Pantone Blue 55



The **Mark** – burgi de Wenlok: Sigillum: commune: (and Device)

The Mark has been registered in respect of:

Class 35:

Advertising, business management and administration, office functions, electronic data storage, advertising services via the Internet, opinion polling, data processing, provision of business information, retail services connected with souvenirs.

Class 36:

Provision of financial information.

Class 41:

Providing training, entertainment and cultural activities.

The Seal has been registered in the name of Much Wenlock Town Council. It can be used by other people with the permission of the Town Council, however the Intellectual Property Office must be informed of whom has been licensed to use the Seal and under what conditions.

Use of the Mark

The use of the Mark on Town Council documents signifies that the documents are valid Town Council documents.

Anyone wishing to use the Mark must apply to the Town Council for consent, by completing the appropriate application form. The Seal cannot be used for commercial purposes.

Authorisation

The Town Clerk has delegated authority to approve the use of the Mark by other organisations.

Renewal

The trade mark must be renewed every ten years.
