MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES, TABLETS AND MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS

For the right to erect or place on a grave in respect of which the exclusive right of burial has been granted (subject to approval regarding design, colour and material).

No kerbstones are permitted in the new sections of the cemetery. Separate vases must have signed approval from the Town Clerk.

Before the erection of memorials, all inscriptions, materials and colours must have signed approval from the Town Clerk. Please ensure that permission is obtained before a memorial is commissioned.

The Town Council reserves the right to remove any unapproved memorial and re-charge the cost.

A NAMM approved ground anchor must be fitted to all memorials on all plots.

All memorials are owned by the families, however the Town Council is not responsible for their safety and security. The Town Council reserves the right to remove any hazardous headstones.

Please note that in pursuance of the Local Authorities Cemeteries Order 1977 the following applies:

- 18. (1) No person shall:
 - (a) Willfully create any disturbance in a cemetery;
 - (b) Commit any nuisance in a cemetery;
 - (c) Willfully interfere with any burial taking place in a cemetery;
- (d) Willfully interfere with any grave or vault, any tombstone or other memorial, or any flowers or plants on any such matter, or
 - (e) Play at any game or sport in a cemetery.
- (2) No person not being an Officer or Servant of the Burial Authority or another person so authorised by or on behalf of the Burial Authority shall enter or remain in a cemetery at any hour when it is closed to the public.
- 19. Every person who commits an unlawful act shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £100 and in the case of a continuing offence to a fine not exceeding £10 for each day, which the offence continues after conviction thereof.
